- There are several questions that most people want answered each day.
- 1. Who am I?
- 2. Where am I?
- 3. Where am I going?

John 4: 19-26 is an account where those questions are addressed.

- John 4: 19-20: Who Am I?..... Where Am I?
- We need to acknowledge the truth about ourselves.
- It is important to recognise where we stand.
 It is significant that we acknowledge who has lived on the land where we now dwell.
 This is why "Acknowledgement of Country" is an important issue in many parts of the World including Australia.
- John 4:21-24: Where Am I Going?
- Worshipping God in Spirit and Truth is a way to face the Future
- John \$:25-26: Acknowledge Christ
- True Worship involves an honest acknowledgement of Christ
