SCRIPTURE READING: ISAIAH 9:1-6A

- **The people walking in darkness** (v2)
 - a) The feeling of disorientation that comes with walking in the dark.
 - b) Darkness on a global scale
 - c) The reality of darkness

- **Where is our Hope?**
 - a) Jesus grew up in Nazareth and His ministry base was Capernaum. Both these locations were in Galilee in the land of Zebulun and Naphtali. (Matthew 4:12-17 and Isaiah 9:1)
 - b) The stigma towards Galilee (John 7:41-42, and 52)
 - c) Jesus is the light (v6)
 - d) The light is a King; the son of a virgin; a child born unto us. He is Immanuel: God with us. (Isaiah 7:14)
 - e) Christmas lights
 - f) Our task is to announce Jesus to the world, as the only hope, that people may find eternal peace with God.
